Submissions will be reviewed by members of the Editorial Board of the *Southwestern Economic Review*, who will then recommend to the Editor whether or not publication is warranted.

For consideration for inclusion in the Fall 2010 issue, please submit your Research Note in a Word document to the e-mail address listed below by September 1, 2010. The total length of text must not exceed 800 words and the title should not exceed 10 words. Numbers may be included, but do not include equations, diagrams, or footnotes. References to previously published works should appear in parentheses within the body of the text and should include the name of the author(s), name of the journal or book, and year of publication.

Members of the Southwestern Society of Economists who presented papers at the Annual Meeting in Houston, Texas in February 2011 are especially encouraged to submit a Research Note based on the paper presented. If accepted, it will be noted in the publication that the Research Note is based on a paper presented at the meetings.
